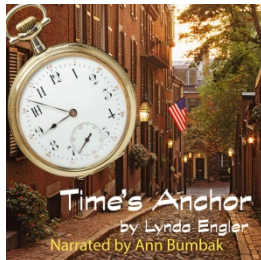

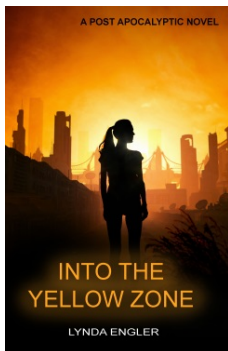

The journey continues...

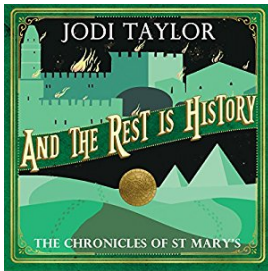

You think you're having a bad day? Max is trapped in ancient Egypt in the deadly sandstorm that buried the 50,000-strong army of the Pharaoh, and she's sharing the only available shelter for miles around with the murdering psychopath who recently kidnapped her and left her adrift in time. Once back at St. Mary's, tragedy strikes again and with no Leon, no Markham, and no Peterson at her side, Max's personal life begins to unravel forcing her to race through time to save her husband and young son.

I can't get enough of Jodi's novels and this eighth book in the madcap time travel series once again had me thoroughly engrossed. Zara Ramm narrates superbly as always, bringing the characters to life in personal ways that will have you laughing and crying right along with them.

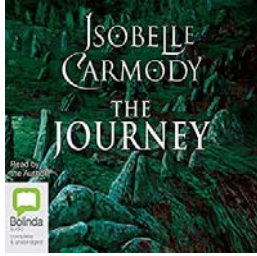
Book Review: [New York Deep](#), by Andrew J. Morgan

Overall ****



An interesting repeating time travel story, a la *Groundhog's Day* but without the humor. This is a serious novel about a tunnel engineer, Josh, who finds a cavern with an unknown energy in it that propels him back in time to relive an event over and over.

Other than some problems with transportation issues in the setting (NY Port Authority bus terminal at W42nd) stemming from his lack of knowledge with the city, it was well written and enjoyable. Those not from New York or New Jersey won't notice the setting inconsistencies. Ignoring that, I enjoyed the novel. The author knows civil engineering and does a fantastic job describing what Josh does on the job and bringing the characters to life.
