




Into the Yellow Zone (Into the Outside Book 2)

This end-of-the-world battle between magic and science which revolves around childhood friends Patricia (the witch) and Laurence (the techno-start up wiz) is a humorous and, at times, heart-breaking exploration of growing up extraordinary in a world filled with cruelty, scientific ingenuity, and magic. Childhood friends Patricia Delfine and Laurence Armstead didn't expect to see each other again after parting ways under mysterious circumstances in middle school. After all, the development of magical powers and the invention of a two-second time machine could hardly fail to alarm one's peers and families. But now they're both adults, living in the hipster mecca San Francisco, and the planet is falling apart around them.
