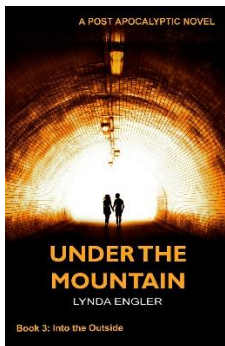
Into the Yellow Zone (Into the Outside Book 2)

Under the Mountain (Into the Outside Book 3)

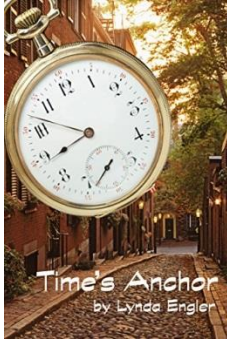

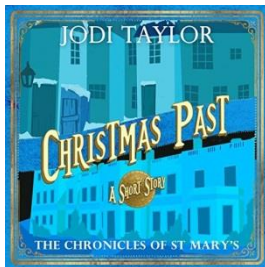
Time's Anchor
